It provides the strong foundation for living out all the purposes in a safe environment and is the glue that holds the your group together when times get tough. This type of community will not happen, however, without direction and focused leadership.
- Encourage group members to make the Bible part of their daily routine, not just something they read for small group study. You may ask, "What verse spoke to you this week?"
