	3.	Watch your  Make sure that your story is understandable by someone who has no history or affiliation with "church speak."			
	4.	Make Jesus the  Remember that the most interesting, important thing about your story (or anyone's) is what Jesus has done. Keep the focus on Jesus and how He has changed your life.
