DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Introductory

1. What stood out to you from this week's devotions?
2. What's something you know to be true, but it doesn't affect the decisions you make?
3. What aspect of the gospel still leaves you in awe? How can you use this to share the gospel with others?

4. Read Romans 15:14-33.
 - a. What does this passage tell us is true about the relationship between the local church and global mission?
 - b. What do verses 22-29 teach about: Strategic planning? Financial generosity (*see devotional question 1*)? Unity in the church?
5. In the sermon this weekend it was said: "If this is true, you have to do that." What truth is Paul convinced of? What does Paul "have to do" with that truth?
6. According to Paul, describe *your* role in God's mission based on the text?
