I was always raised that early is on time, and on time is late. If you show up late, you are likely missing something, some detail, some instruction that will be important. Don't be that person.

- 2. Are you leading your group in such a way that your group members know that this is the expectation?
- 3. How can you make some movements in this area of your leadership?
