What topics will be talked about at camp?

CAMP THEME - "UNSTOPPABLE"

Join us as we **explore the lives of four characters in the Bible** who faced incredible challenges but showed an **unstoppable faith in God**. Through their stories, your kids will discover what it means to be **determined**, **bold**, **passionate**, **and strategic** in their own faith journey!

VERSE

"We have faith. So we understand that everything was made when God commanded it. That's why we believe that what we see was not made out of what could be seen.." - Hebrews 11:30 (NIRV)

During camp, we will have 3 large sessions + 2 Workshops

During large group times, the kids will get to worship, hear stories from the Bible, participate in large group games, and have small group discussions with their group, where they will learn how to apply and live out the truths from the Bible.

Who will be with my child during camp?

→ Every group will be assigned two KIDS leaders. All leaders have gone through reference and background checks and have completed all required safety training.

What other activities will my child be participating in?

→ Throughout the weekend, your child will enjoy a variety of winter games and exciting activities, including the rock wall, 9 Square, glow parties, and so much more!

What are the winter activities?

- → If there's snow, we'll take some time to play outside—building snowmen, making snow angels, and enjoying even more snowy fun!
- → Make sure to pack all your snow gear (pants, coat, hat & gloves)

What if my child takes medication?

→ All medications should be in a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name. Our camp nurses will collect all the medications at check-in and keep them for the weekend. IF you listed any medication or allergies on your registration form, you will be asked to complete an additional medical form and bring it with you to check in. If you have any special medical concerns or instructions before we leave, you will be able to speak with the nurses directly.

What if my child gets injured?

→ Small group leaders will have access to first aid kits for minor bumps and scrapes.

→ The camp nurses will handle all major injuries. If additional medical care is required, you will be contacted. There is an urgent care facility within 20 minutes of camp if needed.

What are the cabin arrangements?

- → All the children and leaders sleep in large cabins separated by gender. The rooms are arranged with bunk beds.
- → Private restrooms and showers are located inside the dorms.

How long is the bus ride?

- → We charter school buses to Heartland Retreat Center
- → The drive is about 47-58 minutes (depending on which campus you leave from).
- → Leaders and students will ride the buses together.

What if my child struggles with sleepovers?

- → All of our kids and group leaders (separated by gender) sleep in the same room and are available if your child needs anything in the middle of the night.
- → The kids are very tired from all of the day's activities, so they usually sleep well.
- → Our group leaders will ensure lights out and wake-up times we know how important a good night's sleep is for elementary-aged kids!!
- → If you would like to attend camp with your child to help alleviate homesickness, you are welcome to attend as a co-leader in your child's group.

What if my child is a picky eater?

- → The food at camp is very "kid-friendly" food, like pizza, burgers, chicken nuggets, eggs, pancakes, cereal, etc.
- → A camp menu will be emailed out before we leave for camp.

What do I do if my child has allergies?

→ If your child takes allergy medication, the nurses will administer that to your child as needed. Please make sure to tell us if your child has any food allergies.

What if there is an emergency and my child needs to come home?

→ We will contact you in the case of an emergency.

Can my child bring their phone?

- → Children are not allowed to bring any electronic devices.
- → Group leaders will send text messages sporadically throughout the weekend to keep you updated!
