Input Series: The Gospel Of Mark

Remembering that the purpose of our Friday groups is "Bringing In" young people to the sphere of gospel influence we will be concentrating on teaching from the Gospels themselves each year.

Every night at the church should be seen as a gospel occasion that our Christian youth can invite their friends along to.

Our small groups will be the "engine room" of our ministry as we encourage our Christian youth to be praying for and evangelising their unsaved friends.

It isn't possible to deal with every passage in Mark during the course of the year and so there has been a process of selection to enable clear presentations wherever possible.

It is worth having a key verse that can be used as the theme for each term:

Term 1 - Mark 1:1 - "The beginning of the gospel about Jesus Christ, the Son of God."

Term 2 - Mark 4:41 - "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

Term 3 - Mark 8:29 - Peter answered, "You are the Christ."

Term 4 - Mark 10:45 - "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many"

The headings for each passage are free to be altered. However, the passages should remain in the order they are written. If an extra night is required, then it can be a "Testimony" night.
