Dear Camper,

We are very pleased to advise you that your application to attend The **HEIST** Summer Camp from 12th-16th January 2026 has been accepted. We look forward to joining with you at Chittick Lodge, Gerringong for a week of challenges as you take part in the biggest **HEIST** in Summer Camp history. This letter will provide you with all you need to know before camp.



Not long after we released the **HEIST** theme for camp, the French Crown Jewels were stolen from the Louvre. The whole job was completed in just 8 minutes! While one piece was recovered the rest of the jewels are yet to be found. During The **HEIST** Camp you will be tested in your ability to plan and complete a heist. This will include planning your entry and escape, avoiding detection from laser beams, CCTV cameras, and security guards. You may need to crack a safe, create a diversion, and then offload the merchandise without leaving a trail of evidence.

During the week we will be looking at the book of Ezekiel as Josh Hayward points us to the glory of God and his plan to complete the biggest heist in history through his son Jesus. You might want to read over Ezekiel before coming to camp.

### TRANSPORT, ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE TIMES

Campers will need to arrange their own transport to and from Sutherland Station. Please have an Opal Card with you to enable travel by train to Gerringong. (School Opal cards don't work in holidays!)

#### **Monday 12th January**

Please arrive at Sutherland Station at 9.30am to be checked off at Platform 2. The first meal at camp will be lunch.

#### **Friday 16th January**

We return to Sutherland Station at 4.43pm. The last food at camp will be Lunch.

**THEMED DINNER** - On the final night we have our themed dress up dinner. Maybe come as a team of criminals, a famous painting, a forensics expert, a safe, a museum security guard, a famous detective.... Get creative!

**TALENT SHOW:** After the last dinner is our annual Talent Show. Come prepared to have a go! A magic trick, a song, a hidden skill, whatever.

**OPTIONAL EXTRAS:** Musical instruments to entertain your fellow campers.  
Board games for interaction during free time.

**DON'T BRING:** Alcohol, any smoking devices or unprescribed drugs  
Lots of packets of junk food  
Any equipment or resources for pranking others  
Matches / lighters / fireworks

### **SCREEN POLICY AT CAMP**

Devices with screens will not be allowed in rooms overnight.  
They will be collected each evening and returned to campers in the morning.

### **MEDICATIONS**
