Since our blanket ministry began in 2017, the Women's Ministry of Calvary Baptist Church has made and donated almost 2,000 blankets to local children facing serious illness/injury, or other traumatic circumstances such as abuse, fire, or loss of family member. Quarterly blanket workshops provide an evening of food and fellowship for attendees as they tie beautiful fleece blankets to be given to local agencies such as Red Cross, Harold's House, Burke Center, Family Crisis, and Heartbeat Pregnancy Center, and foster/adoption agencies.

We are also happy to receive crocheted, knitted, or sewn/quilted blankets made according to our size and material guidelines.
