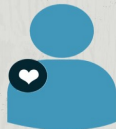

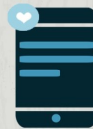

## Day School News—June 2026

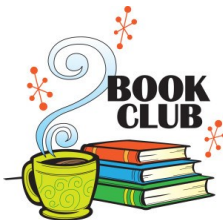

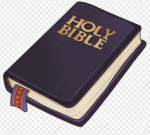

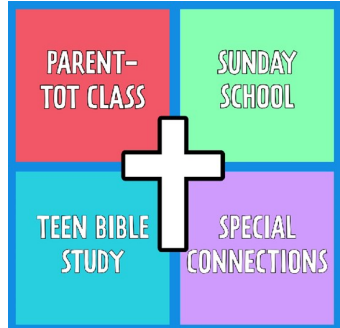

# Pastor's Message

Rev. Dr. Jeffrey Kloha is a very smart guy. He led the Bible study at the pastor's conference I attended recently. The subject was Ephesians and, among the many great points he made, this one stood out for me. When Paul wrote his letters to churches, the Christians in those churches would have been "new Christians." For example, when he writes to the church in Corinth, the people there would have only been Christians for about 5 years. Ephesus, about 8 years. They had no catechism, no New Testament. There were no second and third generation Christians to learn from, to ask questions. This would have created unique challenges for the early church. How blessed are we to have generations of Christians who have come before us. Our faith is rooted in hundreds of generations. When we have questions, there are multiple resources for us. Not just books and studies, but actual people; the "cloud of witnesses" in Hebrews 12, "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith." (Hebrews 12:1-2)
