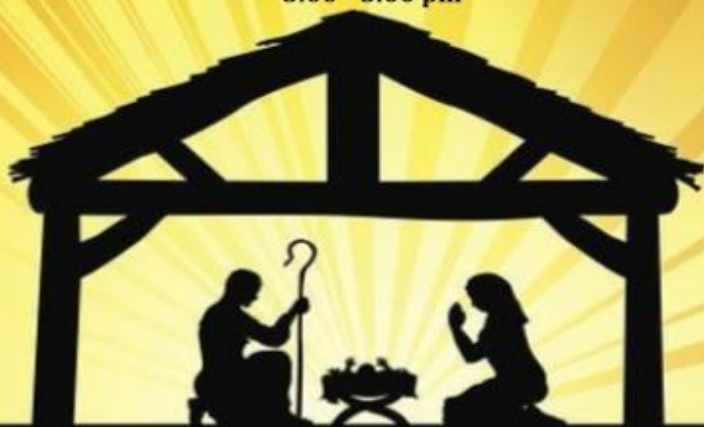

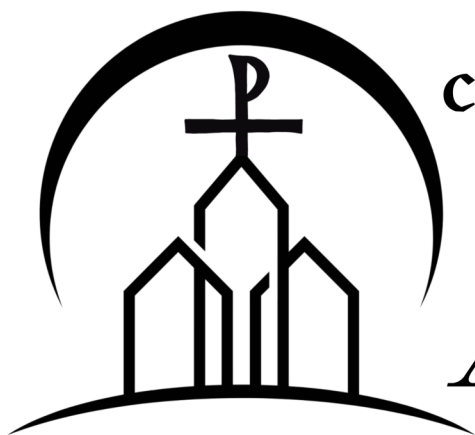

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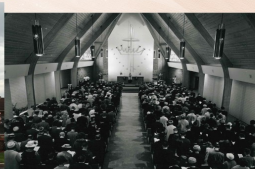

CTK FOOD PANTRY REPORT



Greetings in Jesus' name!

"The 30" volunteers continue to serve in ordering, buying, transporting, sorting, bagging, and distributing purchased and donated food. As you would expect with continuing inflation, we averaged serving a large 72 families/week in August.

Your very generous monetary giving to your Food Pantry and Meijer Simply Give Campaigns have allowed us to make the following changes. We are now returning to give 18 non-perishable foods from Gleaners instead of the 15 we had been giving. For now, we are buying more canned meats and other items instead of refrigerated dairy products until the power is restored. We are committed to buying more from Meijer.

The last Meijer Simply Give Campaign ended in June. It generated more than \$3 million for Midwest food pantries. We received this encouraging report for our own Pantry on August 24. CTK received \$12,970 in food-only gift cards from the campaign! The breakdown is as follows:

- Single donations from cards you and others used: \$ 1,160
- Given on Meijer Double Match Day: 1,390
- Meijer Double Match Donation: 2,780
- Meijer Ladies Pro Golf Association Donation: 5,380
- Additional contributions: 2,260

Fun Facts for this month include: the White chapel, the first worship space, was dedicated on 10/7/1951. There was no permanent power to the chapel at that point, so a large electrical generator was brought in by Charter member, Art Strohschein, so the celebration could go on! In 1958, the area where CTK is located became the City of Southgate (no longer Ecorse Township). Ten years later, in 1968, there was another change of address for CTK, from 15260 Trenton Rd to 15600 Trenton Rd, per the State of Michigan.

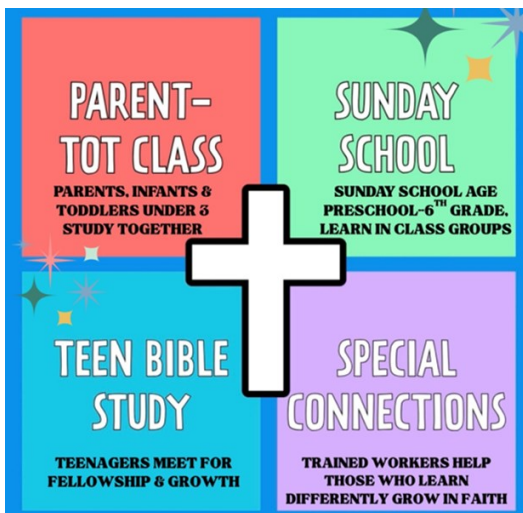

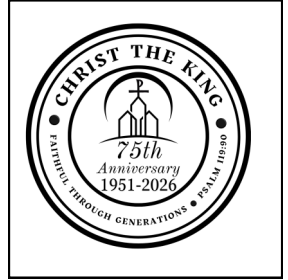
