- Maintain and organize library materials, resources, technology, and circulation systems.
- **Plan, organize, and lead the Scholastic Book Fair twice each year, including setup, promotion, family communication, and overall event management. During Book Fair weeks, this role will temporarily shift to a full-time schedule to support the successful execution of the event.**
- Create a positive, structured learning environment that encourages exploration, responsibility, and respect.
- Integrate Biblical principles into instruction and model Christ-like character.
- Communicate effectively with families and collaborate with teachers to support student learning across all grade levels.
- Participate in school events, chapel services, and other school activities as needed.

- Previous library, literacy, or elementary teaching experience preferred.
- Personal relationship with Jesus Christ and agreement with Greenwood Christian School's Statement of Faith.
- Knowledge of children's literature, literacy development, research skills, and educational technology.
- Strong classroom management, communication, and organizational skills.
