As you purchase supplies, please use these suggestions as a guide:

1. Students should bring all supplies to Back-to-School Night.
2. We do not allow any monsters, demons, Pokémon, Harry Potter, Goosebumps, Yu-Gi-Oh, Five Nights at Freddy's, or anything that can be perceived as evil or scary.
3. PLEASE PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THEIR BACKPACK, COATS, SWEATSHIRTS, LUNCH BOX, AND WATER BOTTLE.
4. Water bottles should not exceed 16 ounces and should have a push/pull spout or flip-up straw.
5. These initial supplies WILL NOT last all year. Please check occasionally with your child to see if glue, crayons, etc., are running low.
6. Please buy pencils that are made in the USA. Some other brands gum up pencil sharpeners.
7. If a specific brand is requested, please purchase that brand.

Supplies Needed

- 15 Expo black dry-erase markers
- 1 pack of 24-count Crayola crayons
- 8 large glue sticks

- 1 pair of pointed-end children's scissors
- 4 large boxes of Kleenex
- 2 composition notebooks (not spiral)
- 1 water bottle (not to exceed 16 ounces; must have a push/pull spout or flip-up straw)
- 6 plastic pocket folders with 3-hole punches (no paper folders, laminated folders, or fasteners)
- 1 2" 3-ring view binder (Plastic pocket on the front)
- NIV Bible (not NIV)
- 24 pre-sharpened #2 pencils

- 1 box 24-count Crayola colored pencils

- 1 package of wide-ruled notebook paper
- Flip-top art box (8 3/8" x 5 5/8" x 2 1/8")
- Book bag or Backpack — NO WHEELS
- Headphones with cord — no Bluetooth or earbuds
- 1 container of hard surface wipes
- 1 box of band aids
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
