

Wireless Communication Device Policy

In accordance with Indiana Code Under 20-26-5-40.7, Indiana students are prohibited from using a wireless communication device during instructional time.

- Instructional time is from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm

Wireless communication devices are devices that have the capability to provide voice, messaging, or other data communications between two or more parties. These devices include but are not limited to:

- Cellular phones
- Tablet or iPad
- Laptop computer
- Smart watches
- Gaming devices
- Air Pods

Students may use their wireless device in the following situations:

- If the device is used to manage the student's healthcare
- Use of the device is necessary for educational purposes
- If the use of a wireless device is included in a student's ISP or 504 Plan

If a student brings a wireless device to school, it must be turned off and kept in the student's backpack. It should not be removed from the backpack at any time during the school day without the permission of the administration or classroom teacher. Failure to

comply will result in the device being secured in the school office and only released to the parent or guardian.
