






Women's Better Together Event Nov. 8th 9am-Noon @ FBC

As many of you know, food insecurity continues to be a growing struggle for families right here in Mercer County. Both the Mercer County Food Pantry and our own FBC Blessing Box are seeing record levels of need.

The Food Pantry has recently put out an urgent plea for more food to meet the increasing number of people walking through their doors. Likewise, our FBC Blessing Box (located in the FBC north parking lot) —open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week—has become a constant source of help for those in our community. Volunteers report restocking the box several times a week with up to seven bags of groceries at a time, and it is often emptied out within hours.

This November, let's come together as a church family to "give a boost" to both the MC Food Pantry and the FBC Blessing Box. We're inviting everyone to bring at least one canned good or other non-perishable food item this month. Donations may be placed in the marked wooden crates in the church lobby any time by Sunday, Dec. 7th.
