- **Spectacular Stories for Curious Kids** – this collection of captivating true stories from history and science was specially curated to inspire young minds and spark curiosity.

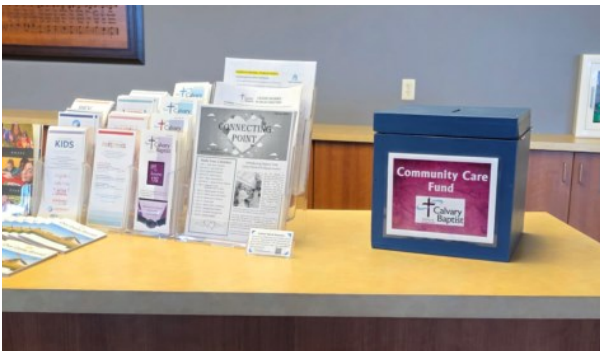
TEENS (grades 7 & up):
