The death of a loved one is a heart-wrenching experience for which we are never fully prepared. The purpose of GriefShare is to provide a strong support system for those who are grieving. Each week, the format consists of teaching and counsel from a team of grief recovery experts via DVD, plus interaction with other group members who have experienced and understand grief. Anyone who is grieving the loss of a loved one is invited to participate. In our sessions, it is amazing how many smiles and laughs we have together walking this hard road.

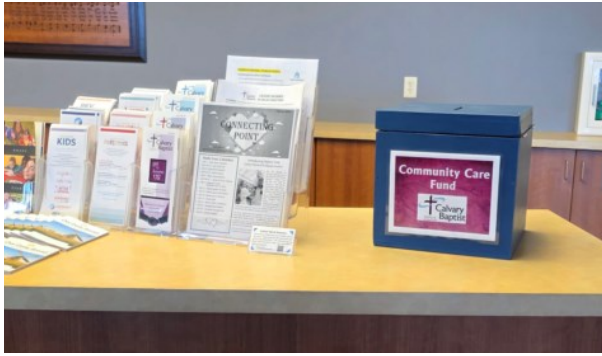

KIDS & TEENS:

- **The Seven** – *The Seven* time-travel adventure series follows a group of kids who are given incredible powers (mapping to the gifts of the spirit) and find each other over the course of the book series. They unite to battle a villain who is trying to disrupt Bible history. (ages 8-12)
- **What a Character! Notable Lives from History** – Inspire your 4th–8th graders with *What a Character: Notable Lives of History*, a book set filled with remarkable stories of faith, courage, and perseverance. Each book brings history to life with engaging accounts of inventors, pioneers, spies, presidents, and more showcasing the character and values that shaped their extraordinary achievements.

ADULTS:

- **Herod & Mary** – Explore the interwoven lives of King Herod and Mary, Mother of Jesus, as author Kathie Lee Gifford brings these biblical figures into a new light. Follow Herod from boyhood as he strives and fails throughout his life to become a beloved king. Walk in the steps of Mary of Nazareth as she navigates the repercussions of Herod's deadly obsession.
- **Anxious for Nothing** - We all experience anxiety, but we don't have to let worry and fear control our lives. *Anxious for Nothing*, by Max Lucado, provides a roadmap for coping with and healing from anxiety by studying Philippians 4:6-7.
- **Cold-Case Christianity: A Homicide Detective Investigates the Claims of the Gospels** - A devout atheist, J. Warner Wallace couldn't imagine believing in the Christian faith—until he applied the same step-by-step investigative process he utilized in his work as a homicide detective to the case for Christianity. In light of the ten common rules of evidence that he'd used to solve crimes throughout his career, Wallace realized he could no longer deny the truth of Jesus Christ. And his life was never the same.
- **The Steadfast Love of the Lord** - Many believers know that "God is love." But whether through cultural lies, false beliefs, or years of mulling over the tragedies of the world, it may be difficult to see the true, steadfast, and unchanging love of the Father. Taking an accessible approach to biblical theology, author Sam Storms explores Scripture to address what God's love is and what it isn't covering God's sovereignty and the saving power, longevity, and sin-killing nature of his love.
