

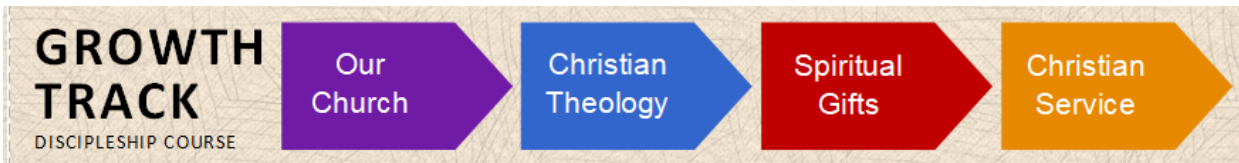

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: HOST TEAMS & USHERS

Our host teams and ushers play a vital role in helping to welcome guests and regular attenders on Sunday mornings. A smile, friendly hello, and taking time to visit create a warm and inviting atmosphere. We are in need of additional volunteers to serve on Sundays.

We have four Host Team Leads who each oversee a host team. Each host team serves for one month at a time, on a rotating basis, for a total of three months throughout the year. Host team members typically serve 1-2 times during their assigned month. There is a Lead Usher on each Host Team as well - the Lead Usher coordinates the ushers for their month.

The Host Teams consist of Lobby Greeters, Connection Center Volunteers, and Outside Greeters. Our Lobby Greeters are stationed in the lobby near the front doors. These team members offer a warm smile and a friendly welcome. The Connection Center is located in the lobby and is staffed by volunteers before and after worship services. Volunteers at the Connection Center will also answer questions about our church and direct people to specific ministry areas (kids' wing, community groups classrooms, etc.). Our Outside Greeters have the first opportunity to greet our guests and help them feel welcome. Positioned at the outside doors, this host team member ensures that guests and members have a positive experience getting to our building by opening doors and offering a friendly hello.

Ushers greet at the main Worship Center doors. They help people feel welcome, assist with people management, help guests find a seat in the worship center, and maintain a safe environment.

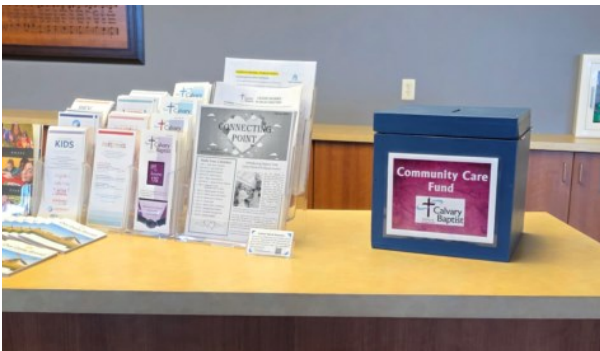
DVDs:

Those people then choose a unique password via the Instant Church Directory app. This directory can be viewed through a mobile app on your phone or tablet or via your laptop or desktop computer.

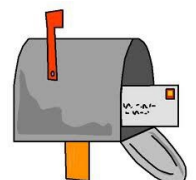
