How To Use feedONE Kids in Your KidMin

Each week of the feedONE Kids curriculum builds on the last, helping your kids grow in their understanding while making a real difference in the lives of children in need. Follow these simple steps to maximize engagement and impact!

Each Week:

Kick off with the feedONE Kids video – Show the video to set the tone and get the kids engaged.

Dive into the lesson – Use the provided memory verses, Bible stories, and activities to explore the week's message.

Collect the offering – Gather contributions in the provided giving box and explain how the kids' giving helps change a child's life.

Wrap up with reflection – Review the key points and reinforce the impact kids can make.

Divide into small groups (optional) – Break into smaller groups for further discussion if your KidMin offers this.

Send home the Parent Take Home – Share the provided resource to engage parents in what their children are learning each week.

Video Schedule:

- **Week 1:** Show the Animated feedONE Explainer.
- **Week 2:** Show the feedONE Animated Kenya Overview.
- **Week 3 (Optional):** Show the Mathare Valley Video (recommended for older children).



Extra Resources:

At the end of the four weeks, send the provided feedONE family flyer home to extend the conversation beyond your KidMin and explain how parents can participate.

Prayer Focus

- Kids who need to be impacted by feedONE

Activity

Have a leader pick a few kids to help them act out different scenarios.

Examples:

- Giving a hug when someone is crying
- Not letting someone play with you
- Taking turns with a video game

Let kids guess if each example shows someone being compassionate or not. Remind them that compassion is love in action!

Craft

Use the provided sheet to make a prayer journal page for Kenya.

Takeaway

I should be compassionate like God is!

Episode 2: Missions

Activity

Leaders: Say the 38 countries feedONE is in (can list/recite 3x).

Have a contest between teams where each team tries to write down as many of the 38 countries as they can.

The winning team gets a prize!

Craft

Have the kids make their own feedONE bracelet saying “feedONE” or “Go” using a bead kit. They can wear these to remind them that through missions we can share the hope found in Jesus in places like Kenya.

Takeaway

God can use what I give to share His love and hope with all people!

Activity

“Generosity Relay”

Divide children into teams and set up a relay course. Instead of passing a baton, they pass a token of generosity. Before passing the token, each player must say a way to show generosity. The first team to complete the relay and cross the starting line wins.

Craft

Episode 4: Speak (Be a Champion)

Activity

Hold a feedONE celebration party! This party can include orange and white balloons and streamers, themed snacks, and fun games. Also, take time during the day to share what each child has learned over the month and how they can continue to be a feedONE champion!

Craft

Give each child an orange poster board. Allow them to decorate it with stickers, draw out what they've learned over the last few weeks, and write down important facts. At the very top on each help them write "I am a feedONE fan!"

Help your

First, have your group come up with a goal, whether it's how many meals they want to provide or how many kids they want to feed. Then, start the "fun"draising!

Here are some ideas to get you started.

feedONE Banks

Give each kid a bank so they can collect money on their own and turn it in once a month.

- Set up a competition (girls vs. boys or whatever teams work for your group). Who can raise the most money over the four weeks?
- Brainstorm other ideas for special one-off contests.

The \$5 Challenge

Give each student \$5. Using the principle of the parable of the talents, see how much they can multiply their initial \$5. For example, they could:

- Buy ingredients to bake cookies and then sell them.
- Buy craft supplies and sell crafts.
- Make hair bows, friendship bracelets, or necklaces and sell them.

The feedONE Family Challenge

Challenge each kid to get x number of family members and friends to feed a child monthly by becoming a “feedONE Family.”

Host a Meal After a Church Service

Gets adults involved to help prep, but the kids can serve the meal. Choose a theme that reflects a feedONE country. You can charge per person or accept donations.

Other Ideas:

- Hold a KidMin car wash.
- Plan a walk-a-thon or bike-a-thon — people can sponsor per mile.
- Do yard work for a donation.
- Take out garbage cans for neighbors.
- Sell toys the kids no longer use.

No matter what “fun”draining you decide to do, have kids share in the adult service on a feedONE Sunday before the offering. The kids will have a chance to teach the adults about God’s compassion.
