

Who can come to Junior Camp?

This camp is a ministry of Chapel of the Lake designed for kids who have graduated from 3rd-5th grade (Birthdays August 1, 2015- July 31, 2018). What will we do there?

Junior Camp is designed to help make and mature 3rd-5th grade grads into disciples of Jesus Christ through exposure to God's Word and to God's world, in the context of intentionally loving relationships built during a week of adventure and fun. Together, we will do all kinds of fun things including; swimming; archery, crafts, nature hikes, competition games, and more. In addition, daily quiet times, scripture memory, lessons from the Bible, memorable cabin discussions, and evening campfire times make Junior Camp a life changing, God-centered experience.

How much will it cost and how do I register?

We make every effort to keep our costs low, which makes this camp such a great value. The \$225.00 registration (Only \$200 if register by May 10!) will cover transportation, meals and activities (including a waterpark trip). If cost is a problem, please contact Pastor Keith, as scholarships may be available. To register, remove the attached registration form, fill it out along with the liability release form, and return it to the Chapel office by **May 25**. All camp fees are due by **May 25**. Please make all checks payable to the Chapel of the Lake. Late registrations will only be accepted if there is room. T-shirt sizes cannot be guaranteed for late registrations.

How will we get there? When will we leave and when will we return?

Transportation is provided by vans and other vehicles driven by Chapel adults. We depart from the Chapel at 1pm on Monday, June 8. Please arrive by 12:30 to allow for a smooth departure at 1pm. We will return to the Chapel around 2:15 pm on Friday, June 12. Please be there to greet your camper!

What do I bring?

Bible, pen/pencil, casual/play clothes, jacket, sheets and a blanket or sleeping bag, pillow, towels and washcloths, swimsuit (one piece/tankini suits for girls), water bottle, personal toilet articles, flashlight, suntan lotion, insect repellent. Optional items: fan, camera, table games, a frisbee, etc...

What not to bring:

If it requires batteries and it's not listed above, don't bring it! (Including cell phones, fireworks, or other inappropriate items)

What about spending money?

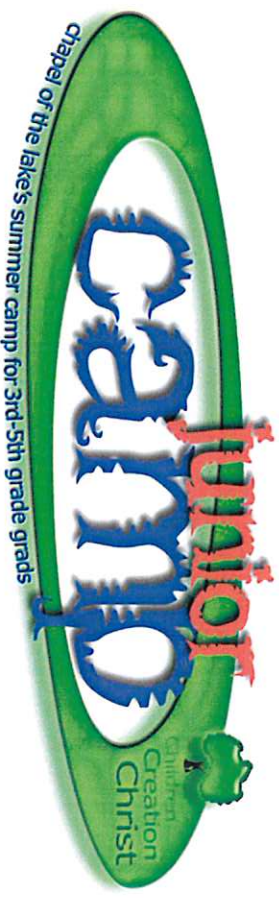

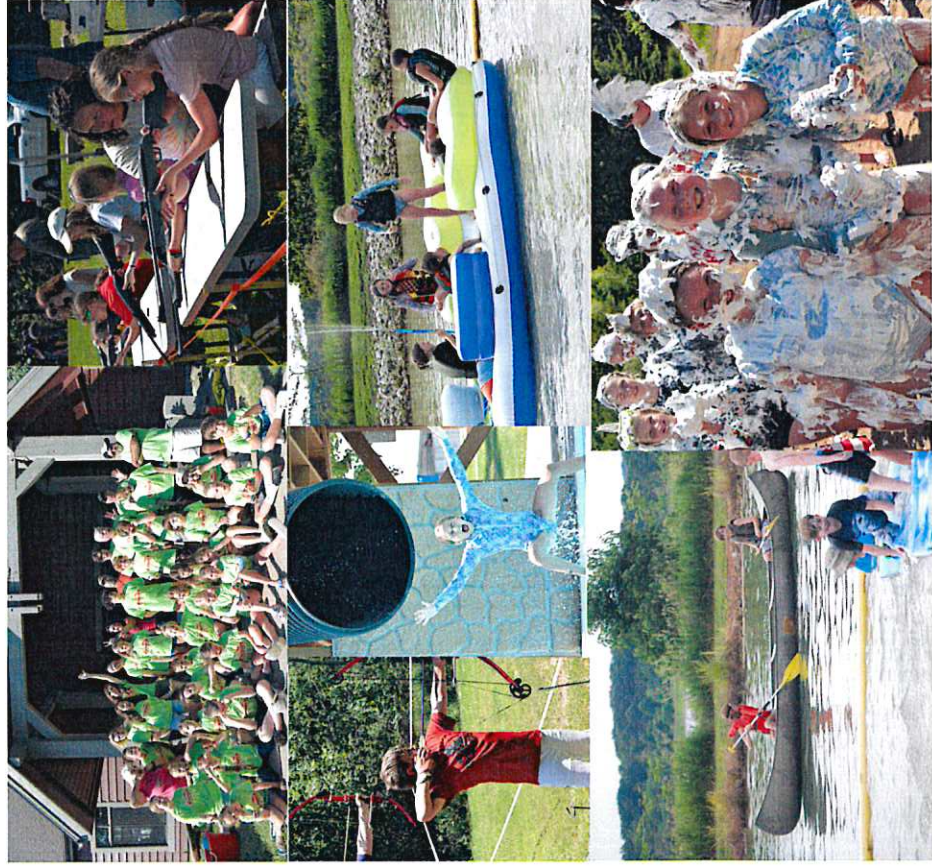
