Music has long been an important part of worship at HTPC. After many years of faithful service, our sanctuary piano is showing signs of wear. It requires frequent tuning, some keys and strings no longer perform as they should, and repairs are becoming increasingly costly.

To help provide a quality piano that will serve our congregation for years to come, we are launching our **"Buy a Key, Build Our Future" Fundraiser** immediately following worship today, **June 21st**.

Our goal is to raise **\$30,000** toward the purchase of an upgraded sanctuary piano.

Piano keys may be sponsored for a minimum donation of **\$200**, and families, friends, Sunday School classes, committees, and other groups are welcome to sponsor a key together. Additional piano parts, including the pedals and bench, are also available for sponsorship. A keyboard display will be available in the **Family Room** where sponsors may add their names and watch our progress throughout the campaign.

Every gift matters. Donations of any amount are welcome and appreciated, and all contributions help bring us closer to our goal.

Donations will be accepted following worship each Sunday until the fundraiser concludes. Gifts may be made by cash or check payable to **HTPC**.
