DRESS CODE

Modesty is the best policy. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times unless it is a pool/lake/water activity.

Girls:

One-piece bathing suits are required.
- *Dark T-shirts can be worn over two pieces suits.*
No spaghetti straps or tube tops
No bare midriffs
No short shorts

Guys:

No speedo-style swimwear
No underwear showing
Shirts **must be worn at all times** outside of the pool/lake/water activities

PACKING:

- Packing Pro-Tips:
- Label all luggage items with your camper's full name and church
- Please limit luggage to no more than 2 bags to make sure your camper can carry all the luggage they are bringing to camp.
- Check the weather before sending your camper to camp – Crestline can be hot, dry, cool, rainy, or muddy throughout the summer – help your camper pack accordingly!



Packing List

- Bible, Journal, Pen (make sure your camper's name is written in their Bible)
- Sleeping Bag & Pillow
- 2 pairs of shoes (worn in, closed toed with good tread and laces)
- Flip flops for showers and pool
- Sweatshirt or jacket (for chilly Mornings/Evenings)
- Beach Towel for Pool Activities
- Flashlight or Headlamp (with fresh batteries)
- Reusable Water Bottle (labeled with your camper's name)
- General Toiletries:
 - Toothbrush & Toothpaste
 - Shampoo & Conditioner
 - Soap / Body Wash
 - Deodorant
 - Sunscreen / Bug Repellent
 - BathTowel & Washcloth
- Clothing for **FIVE** Days
 - Socks & Underwear
 - Swimsuit(guys-trunks//girls-one piece)
 - Shirt that students are comfortable getting wet.
 - T-Shirts
 - Shorts
 - Pajamas

Optional / Encouraged:

- Raincoat / Poncho
- Small Backpack for carrying personal items around camp
- Plastic garbage bag for dirty clothing

Do Not Bring

- **Drugs, alcohol, or weapons**
- Excess money or valuables
- **Cell Phones** or any other electronics
