HOW WILL WE BE SERVING?

- Rainbow Acres is an organization that serves and cares for people with developmental disabilities whom they call “Ranchers”. Rainbow Acres mission is to help Ranchers live to their fullest potential with dignity and purpose and model a Christlike community based in unconditional love, hope, friendship, patience, and joy.
- There are two ways we are going to partner with Rainbow Acres during this trip:
- We will be helping Rainbow Acres with different projects and needs around the facility:
 - Students will serve by cleaning, pulling weeds, painting, moving rocks etc.
- We will also be interacting with the Ranchers as we help with social activities, lead prayer circles, and help with social events.
- Students will serve by leading in prayer and helping with different activities that Ranchers participate in:
 - Social activities include Bible studies, prayer circle, and music, etc.

IS IT SAFE?

- Yes, students will have a leader present with them at all times. Moreover, most of the day will be spent as a large group.

WHERE WILL THEY EAT?

- **Breakfast:** Served in the Diahler Loft exclusively with our team.
- **Lunch:** Served in the Rainbow Acres Lunch Hall, located in the Palmer Center.
- **Dinner:** Each group, consisting of two students paired with one leader, will join the ranchers for dinner in their homes. These groups will be gender-specific.

WHERE WILL MY STUDENT STAY?

- We will be staying in the Diahler loft at Rainbow Acres, which is at the center of the property. There is a boys room and a girls room.
