Kids Camp Packing List

Packing List

The Essentials:

- Bible, notebook, pen/pencil
- Flashlight
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Warm and cool clothing for five days
- Jacket/sweater, waterproof jacket or light rain gear
- Swimsuit (**one-piece for girls**) **If females cannot find a one-piece bathing suit, they will be required to wear a dark-colored shirt over their suit at all times.*
- Towel(s) for swimming
- Comfortable tennis shoes and sandals (for shower only)
- Overnight toiletries
- Bug repellent: lotion, stick, or spritz
- Bath towel and washcloth
- Water bottle
- Upload spending money for activities, snacks, and apparel to Forest Home's website. Use the link emailed to you by HDC Staff (\$15-\$30 recommended)
- Camera (optional)

Recommended:

- Hat for sun protection
- Backpack
- Items to decorate your cabin
- Plastic garbage bag for dirty clothes



Packing List Cont.

The Following Items Are Not Allowed At A Camp

- Cell Phones, radios, computers, gaming devices, anything electronic...you get the idea
- Any electronic games
- Weapons (such as knives, air soft guns, BB guns, slingshots, etc.)
- Avoid preventable heartache; do not send anything that is irreplaceable or very expensive.

A "Must Do" For Luggage

1. Label ALL luggage and items with a permanent marker (name, address, phone, church). We will provide two luggage tags on the day of check in.
2. Make sure that you can carry all the luggage you are bringing to camp. (Wheeled suitcases are **NOT** recommended due to the outdoor terrain.)
3. It may be hot and dry or cool, rainy or muddy when campers arrive at camp, so be ready for anything. You can check the Forest Home website at www.foresthome.org for a weather report.
