



## **2026 Brookwood Church Summer Internship**

**Hours:** 35 hours per week, 7-8 weeks, contract full-time with Canada Summer Jobs Program

**Work Term:** 2x - Community Program Director: June 15th - August 7th, 2026 (8 weeks)  
2x - Recreation Program Leader: June 29 - Aug. August 14th, 2026 (7 weeks)

**Job Description:** Brookwood Baptist Church is seeking four enthusiastic, responsible, and outgoing summer interns to lead our vibrant summer day camps and community engagement programs. In these roles, summer interns will help plan, lead, and run fun, gospel-centered programs for children while also supporting the broader community through program development, communication, and partnership with local organizations. These positions offer valuable hands-on experience in both children's ministry and community engagement within a local church, while equipping interns to grow spiritually, personally, and vocationally as they make a lasting impact in the lives of kids and families.

**Primary Job Responsibilities:** Plan a community-focused summer camp experience for local children that is affordable, accessible, and, above all, fun. As well as organizing three other community-specific support initiatives: the Senior Connection Program (a day of engagement with a local senior care facility), the Community Food Security Initiative (a week of collection and distribution of food for food-insecure families), and the Neighbourhood Beautification (upkeep of two local parks in partnership with the local township).

**Other Responsibilities:**

Lead lessons, games, crafts, sports, and other activities for large and small groups of children  
Recruiting, training, and coordinating volunteers  
Ensure the safety and care of all children in attendance  
Creating advertising materials (print and online), website editing, and social media engagement  
Reaching out to and working alongside other community organizations (Seniors' Home, Food Bank, Township of Langley)  
Other duties as assigned

**Qualifications:** (Must be between the ages of 16-30)

Possess an authentic faith and walk with Jesus Christ  
Organized and able to plan and direct summer camps and community projects  
Fun-loving and able to build relationships with children and their parents  
Willing to learn and carry out duties efficiently and joyfully  
Ability to work independently and as part of a team  
Experience with sports, creative arts/media, and/or teaching kids an asset  
Basic computer skills and willingness to learn digital tools
