September 1

Confident, Anchored

Father, may our children's confidence be anchored in the knowledge that Your Presence is with them wherever they go. **Joshua 1:9 NIV**

September 2

God's Promise

May our children rid themselves of the fear and discouragement that tries to overwhelm them and stand firm, confident and strong; in Your promise to always be with them. **Joshua 1:9 NIV**

September 3

A Time to Pause

Instead of fear stopping our children in their tracks, may it be a signal for them to pause, pray and lean into God's Presence with them. **Joshua 1:9 NIV**

September 4

Focus

May our children's focus be on the positives of God's direction and promise and may they trust Him to overcome the negatives seen in the natural. May the enemy be unable to rob them of the victory found in trusting God. **Numbers 13:23-31 NIV**

September 5

In the Lord's Presence

Like Samuel did in the presence of the Lord, may our children grow in stature and favor with God and man. **1 Samuel 2:21, 26 NKJV, NLT**

September 6

Past the Natural, Move Forward

Like Caleb, may our children be people of faith who see past the natural even when it is full of negativities, seemingly impossibilities and potential defeats. May they move forward trusting God and holding on to His promises. **Numbers 13:25-30 NIV**

September 7

Full of Faith Like Caleb, may our children be blessed with hearts full of faith that filter their situations through the truth of God's Word and the promises He made. **Number's 13:30 NIV**

September 8

Faith, Encouragement

Unlike Caleb, cause our children to be surrounded by people of faith who are full of encouraging words rather than with those who spread doubt. **Numbers 13:31 NIV**

September 9

A Different Spirit Like Caleb, may our children have a different spirit that chooses obedience, courage and optimism when the majority is leaning into fear and negativity. **Numbers 13:30, 31, 14:24 NIV**

September 10

Walk in Truth

May our children walk before the Lord in Truth with all their heart and soul all the days of their lives. **1 Kings 2:4 NKJV**

September 11

Shift Your Perspective

Cause our children to develop new perspectives and may their daily challenges be viewed by the size of God instead of the size of the situation they face. **Numbers 13:30 NIV**

September 12

Take God at His Word

In times when our children's walk with God is not easy, may they refrain from murmuring and complaining. May they overcome their feelings of fear, take God at His Word and cling to Him as they move forward. **Number 14:1-2, 9 NIV**

September 13

Right and Wrong

Father, give our children understanding hearts that know the difference between right and wrong. May they have the strength of character and the courage to do what is right in Your eyes and not their own. **1 Kings 3:9 NLT**

September 14

Abundantly Blessed

Like Solomon, may the Lord bless our children with more than they asked for. May they follow and obey Him in all they do and may they be given the blessing of a long life. **1 Kings 3:13, 14 NIV**

September 15

Stand Firm

Father, may our children have the strength and courage to stand firm in the truth even when they are in the minority.

Numbers 13:31, 32 NIV

September 16

Trust, God's Provision

Unlike the Israelites, may our children be people who trust God to provide all they need to succeed in the things He calls them to do and may they know He will enable them to do it.

Numbers 13:31-33 NIV

September 17

Press Forward, Destiny

When life gets challenging, remind our children to press forward into their God given destiny rather than retreating into familiar unhealthy habits of the past.

September 18

Faithful Peers

Father may our children be surrounded by peers who inspire faith, point them to do Your will and cause them to keep their eyes fixed on Jesus.

September 19

Discernment

Father, bless our children with discernment regarding the voices they listen to. May they choose faith over rebellion and move fearlessly forward into their destiny.

September 20

Opportunities to Trust

May our children see all their fears as opportunities to trust God. May their fear of the Lord cause them to be in awe of Him and inspire them to move closer to Him.

Lying

Remind our children that lying is always a sin no matter what the attitude or motive and that God will be merciful to them when they ask for forgiveness and do their best to follow His way of life.

Scary or Unpopular

Like Rahab, may our children stand up for their faith and help others even when it feels scary or unpopular.

People of Action

Like Rahab, may our children be people of action who do exactly as the Lord leads them and may their actions lead to seeing their entire household and all their relatives being saved.

September 24

Priorities

Like Davids instructions to Solomon, may our children, their children and their children's children also prioritize total obedience to God in all their ways in all aspects of life.

God Honoring Character

Father, shape our children's character to honor You in everything, in every way and in every environment.

Wisdom, Discernment

Father, bless our children with wisdom and discernment to address difficult situations and toxic influences.

Holiness, Justice
