## July 1

### God's Ceaseless Abiding

### In Righteousness and Integrity

Father, remind our children that hurt feelings don't justify disobedience. May they be reminded of their destiny to live in righteousness and integrity.

### Encouraged and Unafraid

May our children be encouraged and unafraid because God is with them and will help them, strengthen them and hold them up with His victorious right hand.

Isaiah 41:10 NLT

### Truthful Words

Cause our children to speak truthful words that stand the test of time.

Proverbs 12:19 NLT

## July 7

### Fear

If the shadow of fear tries to envelop our children, may they be able to declare with trust and certainty, "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?"

## July 8

### Bold, Fearless, Effective

Because God has not given our children a spirit of fear but of power, love and a sound mind, may they be bold, fearless and effective workers for Him in the power of the Holy Spirit.

## July 9

### Testifying

Father, may our children never be ashamed or fearful to testify about the Lord, relying on the Holy Spirit for courage.

II Timothy 1:8 NLT, NKJV

### Without Fear

Even in the darkest valley, may our children be unafraid because the Lord is close beside them.

### Fear

When our children feel afraid, may they put their trust in God.

### Set Things Straight

May our children follow God's way of returning good for evil and trust Him to set things straight.

## July 13

### Trust God

Like Joshua, when our children face obstacles doing God given assignments, may they trust God to be with them and to go before them. Remind them that God will not fail them nor abandon them.

### Kind and Forgiving

Father, may our children be kind to one another, tenderhearted, and forgiving.

Ephesians 4:32 NLT

## July 15

### Broken, Not Disqualified

Remind our children that like Mephibosheth who was given a royal seat at the king's table, we, too, are given a permanent place in God's family because His grace embraces our weaknesses and honors us despite our physical or spiritual limitations.

II Samuel 9:7 NIV

## July 16

### Restored, Adopted

As David restored Mephibosheth's families land and treated him as a son by giving him a permanent seat at the king's table, God also restores us and through adoption gives us a permanent place in His family.

II Samuel 9:7-11 NIV

## July 17

### Bring Hope

Like David, may our children be ones who reach out to those who may feel forgotten or marginalized and may their act of kindness bring hope to those who feel overlooked and are in need.

II Samuel 9:3-5 NIV

## July 18

### Kindness of God

Like David, may our children be motivated to show others the same kindness that God shows them.

II Samuel 9:3 NIV

## July 19

### Honor, Favor, Change

Remind our children that the honor and favor of being at the King's table does not take away all their weaknesses but will change the way they think about themselves and others.

II Samuel 9:7, 8 NIV

## July 20

### God's Will, His Pleasure

Remind our children it was God's will and it brought Him great pleasure to adopt them into His family. May joy and gladness be their response to his favor.

Ephesians 1:5 NKJV, NLT

### Divine Providence

May our children see God's divine guidance working in their lives and acknowledge that they did not get to where they are by chance.

### Working for Their Good

May our children explore the events in their lives that are described as mere coincidences and find that God is actively working in the circumstances of their story for their good.

### Rewarded

May the Lord, under whose wings our children take refuge, reward them fully for the good things they do.

### Blessed In Return

Father, inspire others to show kindness to our children and may they be blessed in return for that kindness.

### Odd Advice, Godly Advice

Like Ruth, may our children have people in their lives who are wise, kind, trustworthy and filled with moral integrity. May they listen to the godly advice they are given and willingly follow it even if that advice seems odd.

### Choose Wisely

May our children refuse to let rude remarks and insults ruin their day or dictate their emotional state. May they choose their battles wisely and brush off the minor offences that come their way. Proverbs 12:16 NIV
