Cause our children to believe in Jesus and receive the blessing of believing without actually seeing Him.

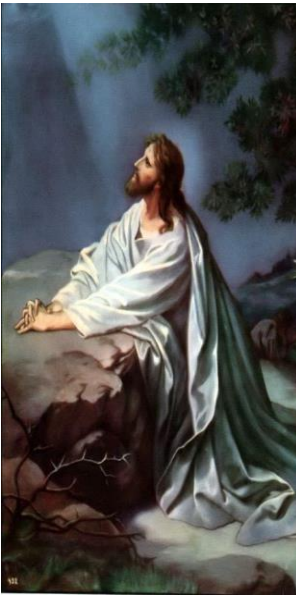
