



Week 5
Christmas Day-Jesus' Birthday!
Isaiah 9:6-7

Talk about it

Gather your family and encourage your child to re-tell the Christmas story using the cube. Remind your family how an angel came to Mary and Joseph and gave them **peace** by reminding them that God is in control. Call attention to the shepherds and remark how they had **joy** when the angels told them that Jesus had been born in Bethlehem. Talk about the wise men's long journey and how they had **hope** that the promise God had made had finally come true. Lastly, look at Baby Jesus in the manger and remember how God showed us His **love** that first Christmas by sending His Son to earth so that we can have a relationship with Him.

Remark that each one of these people's lives were changed when Jesus came to earth!

Read it

Isaiah 9:6-7

Sing it

"All Glory be to Christ"

Do it

- **Happy Birthday, Jesus!**
 - Place the muffins on the Happy Birthday Jesus plate, light the white (Christ) candle and sing Happy Birthday to Jesus!
- Talk about the people on the ornament, talk about the names of Jesus that Isaiah reference in 9:6 and then hang it on your Christmas tree. You might want to mark "2024" on the back of the ornament as a remembrance of Advent 2024.

Pray it

Take some time to pray as a family.
