## LPA'S BLOG

It's your friendly neighbourhood LPA, Adriene here!

If you haven't already heard.... Totus Tuus is just a week away! You may have seen the posters around the Church over these past couple of months, if you looked closely you would have noticed that Sam chose pictures from the year that I was a Totus Tuus missionary in 2019. For the next two weeks, Fr Michael has given Sam and I the chance to share what our experiences were like as previous Totus Tuus missionaries (yes, Sam and I were both missionaries but during different summers).

In a nutshell, I loved being a missionary for Totus Tuus. I have always loved working with children now combined with teaching them about Jesus was truly my cup of tea. A definite highlight was singing the infamous Totus Tuus song, "Rise and Shine" for 5 weeks straight.... every. single. morning. It is sung every morning as a way to energize the campers (and probably the missionaries too). I didn't realize how much energy I truly had in me until the last week of camp. However, I am looking forward for "Rise and Shine" to make it to our parish. I guarantee it will be stuck in your head too.

When I reflect on my experiences as a missionary, I think to myself - Totus Tuus is truly the gift that keeps on giving. Through my formation as a missionary and through the experience of running a Christ-centred camp has led me to fall in greater love with Jesus and the Catholic faith while also enkindling a passion for parish ministry and helping others know the love of Christ through an authentic and joyful witness. To be more specific, being a missionary for Totus Tuus gave me the tools to deepen my prayer life and it increased and renewed my devotion to the Eucharist. If you've seen me at Mass, you would have noticed that I wear a veil. I started wearing a veil during the summer that I was a Totus Tuus missionary as a response to this renewed, deep, devotion I found in Jesus present in the Eucharist.

Every year there is a different theme the camp focuses on. During my year, our theme was on the Sacraments so every lesson both for the day program and the evening program, centred on one of the sacraments. It was also during this time as a missionary where I developed a greater interest in the sacraments and just felt in complete awe of great gift that is offered in them. Fitting that a little over a year later, I would end up working as a Lay Pastoral Associate, tasked with coordinating sacramental preparation.

It was also pretty memorable journeying with 3 other like-minded individuals who were on my team for that summer. It was also a gift to witness my female team mate discern her call to religious life while we were on Totus Tuus. Throughout the summer it was incredible journeying with her as she shared the various movements she had in her heart as to what next steps God was calling her to. She is currently a novice with the Franciscan Sisters of the Renewal and has taken the name Sr. Colette Andre. Please say a prayer for her!

Though from an outside perspective, being a missionary for Totus Tuus may just look like a "Catholic Summer Camp Counsellor", however the intensive training and time of prayer that goes into the formation of these missionaries, truly goes beyond just being a camp counsellor. I thank God for the very gift that becoming a Totus Tuus missionary was as it truly called me outside of myself to serve others and to realize how He wanted to utilize my imperfect gifts for the building up of His kingdom.

Lets rise and shine and give God the glory, glory as we draw nearer to welcoming our Totus Tuus missionaries,
