LPA's Blog - Advent Retreat Spiritual Nuggets

Last week we had the honour to read about Sam's experiences during the Advent Retreat we hosted back on December 2nd. Before I share my main takeaways from this retreat, I wanted to begin this blog by jumping back to 2022 where we had Fr Thomas Lim lead us in our parish Lenten retreat. When he began his talk, he said something that forever changed my disposition whenever I attend retreats. He said...

"In every retreat or pilgrimage, the Lord wishes to impart a special grace or gift for you - a spiritual nugget of some kind. Don't try to accumulate all kinds of spiritual gifts, rather seek the one blessing that he has in store for you!"

In the hustle and bustle that comes with coordinating retreats, I was looking forward to receiving my spiritual nugget from the Lord. Dr Lombardi led the retreat by breaking down the "Our Father" line by line to better recognize and understand the profound beauty and truth behind this prayer. She concluded each of her two talks with songs which is what ended up being my spiritual nugget from this retreat!

I was amazed at how each of these songs in some way connected with the "Our Father". The first song she played was called "O God Beyond All Praising". She prefaced the song by saying that it's words directly mirrors the prayer of Our Father. This song is probably one of my most favourite hymns but I never linked it to this prayer. Before playing it she also encouraged us to reflect on what it means to rejoice in hope and to keep the faith. I was particularly touched by this lyric, "and whether our tomorrows be filled with good or ill, we'll triumph through our sorrows and rise to bless you still." I was reminded of the line, "thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven". Our good Father in Heaven sees us and knows us, so even through life's challenges we can rest in His plans knowing that He is trustworthy and good.

The second song was more of a contemporary song called "You Say" by Lauren Daigle. This song cuts straight to the heart as it addresses our frailties and weaknesses and what the Lord has to say about all of them. It speaks truth into the doubts and discouragements that sometimes arise in our hearts. If there is one thing I take away from this song it's that any fears, doubts, and discouragements take their proper place in the presence of God our Father.

During this Christmas season, I encourage you to take these songs to prayer and allow the Lord to speak to you through them. Perhaps there is a spiritual nugget the Lord wants to give you through them too.
