Pastor's Corner

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus which we celebrated on Friday June 12th is a feast that invites all of us to contemplate the boundless love and mercy of Christ revealed in His pierced Heart. It is also observed throughout the Church as the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests.

Pope Leo XIV has reminded us that the Sacred Heart is not merely a devotional image but a way of contemplating the entire mystery of Christ from His Incarnation to His Death, and Resurrection. From His pierced side flow the mercy, healing, and grace that renew the Church and strengthen her mission in the world.

In a particular way, the Holy Father calls priests to draw their lives and ministry from the Heart of Christ. The priestly mission, he says, is one of sanctification and reconciliation, helping to build up the Body of Christ in unity and peace. So, He encourages priests to love God and His people generously, staying close to their flock and serving without reservation or favour. Rooted in Christ's heart, priests are called to be builders of communion and instruments of reconciliation in a world often marked by division and conflict.

As we honour the Sacred Heart, especially in the month of June, I would invite you to join me in praying for all priests, especially those who have served our parish and for Fr Laszlo Nagy as he takes up his appointment on June 24th. May the Heart of Jesus continue to sanctify them, strengthen them, and make them faithful shepherds after the heart of the Good Shepherd
