Youth Minister's Blog

First and foremost I would like to apologize for missing a couple of Sundays, but I am back now! As Fr. mentioned last week in his blog, I was away up North in Haliburton with our youth (about 170 of them to be exact, from parishes all over Etobicoke, Brampton and Mississauga) attending Edge Camp West!

I have been volunteering for Edge camp for 7 years now, first I went as a teen leader, then I went as an adult leader, then as a high school leadership camp facilitator. So It's safe to say that I know this camp well and it is always the highlight of the summer! Early mornings with the beautiful sunrise over the lake, the loud sounds of chatter as we eat as a group at every meal, watching the youth conquer their fear of heights and having others cheer them on and encourage them, and of course witnessing God working in the lives of young people is always the best - and the reason I do what I do!

However, this year was my first year going as a youth minister bringing three young people from our own parish! It doubled the excitement but it also doubled my worries and fears. I know and have seen first hand the beauty that Edge Camp produces in the faith lives of young people and I had such high expectations, but there was also the worry that the youth I brought would get nothing out of it and that I essentially "failed". I prayed about this unceasingly for months before camp and the fruit from that prayer was...

Never put limits on what God can do (He will surprise you every time).

For as little sleep as all the leaders got, for how tired we were going from activity to activity with the youth who have WAY more energy than we do - we all agree that we would do it all over again to witness them having a personal encounter with our Lord!

Shameless plug time: If you know a young person who is going into grade 6-8 this school year who loves outdoor activities like swimming, zip lining and rock climbing, who wants to make friends who share the same faith and who wants to deepen their own relationship with Jesus... consider not only telling them about Edge Camp for next year but just signing them up! I can't tell you how many kids are reluctant to go but by day five, don't want to leave. That's all for now! We are entering our second year of Youth Ministry here at St. Mary's and we have exciting things planned - stay tuned and thank you for all your continued prayers!
