Youth Minister's Blog: National Eucharistic Revival Meets Totus Tuus Summer Camp?

Hello! It's me again! I feel like I was just sharing my experience about Steubenville, now I'm back to share my experience from our summer camp!

First and foremost, praise the Lord, we made it! We have been running our summer camp from Sunday, July 14th to Friday, July 19th and we definitely could not have done it without this beautiful village we find ourselves in. Thank you to the guest priests who came in to celebrate Mass with our campers on Monday and Tuesday. Thank you to the family that opened their home to missionaries and to the families who provided lunch and dinner and kept them well fed! Thank you to our missionaries and our fantastic volunteers! And as always, the biggest thank you to Fr. Michael for allowing us to have this summer camp, for welcoming them into Mass, giving them a Church tour and participating in the water fight!

Secondly, let's talk about the [National Eucharistic Revival](#) that took place in the United States this past week.

"But Sam..." (You're probably asking yourself), "what does this have to do with Totus Tuus?"

Great question. I'm getting there.

The whole week of camp I have been seeing clips shared on social media from the National Eucharistic Revival happening in Indianapolis, Indiana and I was having major FOMO (F.O.M.O is an acronym for the Fear Of Missing Out). For those who may not know, the National Eucharistic Revival as they define it, is "the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the Church in the United States to the divine invitation to be united once again around the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist." It was five days of talks, Eucharistic Adoration, Spiritual Exhibits and more. I was thinking to myself, if we didn't have camp this week I totally would have gone! And then I thought...Well, we are kind of doing the same thing here but on a smaller scale.

Totus Tuus summer camps have always had a beautiful focus on Mary, but it also has a beautiful focus on the Holy Eucharist. The best part of each day of camp was when we got to go Mass together and during the Mass we were able to acknowledge the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist by singing 'O Sacrament Most Holy'. For our evening program we even had a night where the teens got to experience a Holy Hour! While the Eucharistic Revival was large, beautiful and very much needed, it starts at home in our own parishes. We can foster a culture of Eucharistic reverence right here!

Similar to the theme of Steubenville, I can see these young campers being a hope-filled light to the world! With their infectious personalities, joy for learning more about the faith and their unrestrained love of the Lord! I can see a new generation inspired and vitalized by the Holy Eucharist!
