PASTOR'S BLOG

"A Down and Out Parish"

This weekend we come to the conclusion of our parish mission as we celebrate the solemnity of Pentecost - the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon Mary and disciples, the birthday of the Church. These grace-filled days have been inspiring for myself and I hope for all of you, wherever you might find yourself in the pilgrimage of faith that we walk together. I am grateful for Fr Allan to make himself available to us for 11 days in preaching the mission. Most missions begin on the weekend and then go for three days, so this is double the effort. I am also grateful for all the support that the parish mission has received from our dedicated sacristan, lectors, altar servers, ushers and cantor. Their presence and service are a blessing to all of us who attend the mission, elevating it and allowing us to receive what the Lord is giving.

Fr Allan in his homily over Ascension weekend, and through the mission wants every parish to be described as a "down and out" parish - calling down the Holy Spirit and going Out into the world to "announce the Gospel of the Lord." My prayer intention is that we embrace this invitation so that we can become the lighthouse of Port Credit - a harbour of refuge and beacon of hope.

Corpus Christi Procession

One way to embrace this invitation is to join us for our annual Corpus Christi procession on June 22nd following the 11am Mass. Following the procession, we will have a time to build community with our parish BBQ in the parking lot (weather permitting - the hall will be used in the case of rain).

Confirmation

It has become one of the little 't' traditions of St. Mary's to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on the Vigil of Pentecost using the Extended Vigil option. It is a beautiful Mass that reveals God's plan of salvation to send the Holy Spirit into the world for its renewal after the fall through additional readings from Sacred Scripture. This year we welcome Bishop Ivan Camilleri to administer the Sacrament to the 16 young people of our parish. Please keep them, their sponsors and families in your prayers.

June: The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Finally, I want to draw your attention to the [beautiful letter](#) written by Frank Cardinal Leo on the Sacred Heart of Jesus for the month of June. The first paragraph of the letter brings attention to the solemnity being celebrated in this Jubilee Year:

"This year the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is commemorated on June 27th though the entire month is dedicated to this long-standing and much appreciated devotion in the Church. As Pilgrims of Hope during the Jubilee Holy Year we recall the words of Pope Francis, 'Hope is born of love and based on the love springing from the pierced heart of Jesus upon the cross' (Spes non Confundit, 3)"

Another beautiful reflection is from Fr Brian Gannon, Executive Director of the Courage Apostolate which can be found [here](#). He reflects that hope is born when we first accept the infinite love of God, and that love of God is found in the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He writes:

"The Sacred Heart reminds us that God Himself in the Flesh suffered extraordinarily physical wounds of Love. Literally pierced by a lance. Yet in the Resurrected Body, with the wounds still visible, this devotion tells us that all our humanity has been redeemed. When baptized, every part of us is consecrated holy to God. Secondly, that if we seek real intimacy with Christ, we must expect our hearts to be pierced as well, by the adversity of countering the world, the flesh, and the devil. But such piercing then leads to greater purity of heart, dying to self and the freedom that God's grace gives us. The devil does not want us realizing the transformative effect; he wants us only to think about suffering by itself rather than suffering as the means through which love is purified and thus becomes more joyful, powerful, and hopeful."
