## PASTOR'S BLOG

Since June/July 2024, I have been advertising a pilgrimage to Italy. Well, that date has come! On February 20th, we make our way to Rome and from there we will be travelling to Assisi, Florence, Siena, back to Rome and then finish the pilgrimage in Orvieto. Having looked over the more detailed itinerary and calendar, with Mass locations booked I am certainly excited about this pilgrimage.

The first reason that I am excited about this pilgrimage is because this is a jubilee year. One of primary spiritual practices in a jubilee year is to visit designated holy sites. Going to Rome gives us the privilege of visiting the four major basilicas in Rome and their established Holy Doors. Pope Francis in the document that officially proclaimed the 2025 Jubilee Year wrote, "In Catholic tradition, the Holy Doors represent the passage to salvation - the path to a new and eternal life, which was opened to humanity by Jesus." Pope St. John Paul II wrote in the document that officially proclaimed the 2000 Jubilee Year, the Holy Door "evokes the passage from sin to grace which every Christian is called to accomplish. Jesus said: 'I am the door' (John 10:7), in order to make it clear that no one can come to the Father except through him. This designation which Jesus applies to himself testifies to the fact that he alone is the Savior sent by the Father. There is only one way that opens wide the entrance into the life of communion with God: this is Jesus, the one and absolute way to salvation. To him alone can the words of the Psalmist be applied in full truth: 'This is the door of the Lord where the just may enter '(Psalm 118:20)." From both Pope St. John Paul II and Pope Francis what is made clear is that passing through a Holy Door is a powerful reminder of God's mercy and the call to conversion.

If you are not able to travel, I would invite you to visit the [Archdiocese of Toronto Jubilee 2025](#) website to learn about how you can participate in the Jubilee Year in the diocese. On the website you can learn which churches have been named "Pilgrimage Churches" and how to make a pilgrimage to those churches. Also on the website is a link to understanding Plenary Indulgences and Jubilee Indulgences along with other resources.

The second reason that I am excited about this pilgrimage is that I am going to a few places I have never been to. I have been to Rome and Assisi in the past, but the other stops are going to be new to me. Looking forward to seeing the beautiful architecture in Florence and getting to celebrate Mass near the relics of St. Catherine of Siena.

The last (but not least) reason that I am excited about this pilgrimage is that we are going to Orvieto and the Church which houses the Corporal from the Eucharistic Miracle. Here is an [article that I read](#) that certainly peaked my desire to go and visit as a pilgrim.

With that, this will be my last blog until I return on March 3rd. The last time I went on pilgrimage, I returned with a lot to say and express. I don't expect anything different this time around!
