## PASTOR'S BLOG

### Sacred Heart Devotions

The month of June is dedicated to The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Archbishop Francis Leo has written a letter for the faithful on our devotion to the Sacred Heart. [You can find the letter here](#). Within the letter you will find a history of the devotion, an understanding of the devotion from the "Directory of Popular Piety and Liturgy", and how Sacred Scripture shapes our devotion to the Sacred Heart and the fruit it should produce in our own lives.

A priest friend of mine wrote a nice message to his flock on the occasion of the month of June and devotion to the Sacred Heart. With his permission, I am posting it here for you.

The month of June has traditionally been dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the Litany of the Sacred Heart we say, "Jesus meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine." Humility is defined by the Catechism as, "The virtue by which a Christian acknowledges that God is the author of all good. Humility avoids inordinate ambition or pride, and provides the foundation for turning to God in prayer."

Contrary to humility is pride, which is defined by the Catechism as, "One of the seven capital sins. Pride is undue self-esteem or self-love, which seeks attention and honour and sets oneself in competition with God." To celebrate the vice of pride, already contradicts the life that we are called to live as Christians.

It would seem that in order to turn towards God, it requires humility not pride. During the month of June, I am asking all of our parishioners to have an increased devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to make reparations for our sins and those of the whole world. Some practical devotions:

- 1) Make a regular Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament.
- 2) Enthrone an image of the Sacred Heart in your home and consecrate your family to the Sacred Heart
- 3) Recite the Litany of the Sacred Heart daily
- 4) If these seem all too daunting, simply say each day, "Jesus meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine."

On Friday June 7th, the 1st Friday of the month of June and also the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, I would like to personally invite you to St. Mary's Holy Hour in the evening at 7pm.

### Pilgrimage to Italy

To celebrate the Jubilee Year 2025, I will be the spiritual guide for a pilgrimage to Italy. The pilgrimage is 12 days from February 18th to March 1st. You can find around the church the proposed itinerary. At the end of June, we will have an information evening with the pilgrimage co-ordinator.


