PASTOR'S BLOG

At the beginning of the Advent season, we had the great joy to begin the new liturgical year of hearing from Dr Josephine Lombardi at our retreat, "Lord, teach us to pray". This request of the apostles to Jesus still resonates in our lives, as we come to the parish, to the Church (the Mystical body of Christ on earth) to learn how to pray. I have always believed that our parishes should be a "school of prayer" where we are able to grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ, to trust in Him and receive the life and love that He offers to His disciples. It is within this relationship that we are nourished in His pastures, protected from the wolves and led towards eternal life, our heavenly homeland.

After a time of discernment and asking the Lord how to make our parish more a "school of prayer", we noticed that we do not have a specific "prayer ministry" at St. Mary's and such a ministry would be the fruit of our retreat, "Lord, Teach us to Pray." Having a ministry in the parish dedicated to prayer is something that everyone can be a part of and can contribute to the sharing of the life and love of Jesus Christ as His disciples. From my experience, having been a priest at parishes with prayer groups, and growing up in a parish with a very strong and vibrant prayer group, I have noticed the fruits in the parish community with them and I pray and hope for the same at St. Mary's.

What will this "Prayer Ministry" look like?

In our time of prayer asking this question, there were four main areas that we would like to add to what already exists and continue to grow: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, the Rosary, Intercessory Prayer and the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

Beginning in February, on the first Friday of the month, we will have an additional hour of adoration in the evenings from 7-8pm followed by a time of fellowship in the hall. On the first Saturday of the Month, we will have a time of Intercessory Prayer following Mass and devotions to St. Michael. On every Friday of the month, at 3pm we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet over zoom. And finally, we would like to have our daily Rosary before Mass grow with parishioners dedicated to lead the prayers.

Over the next couple of weeks, we will continue to communicate more about this prayer ministry. My invitation to you is to pray for the success of this "prayer ministry" with the following prayer:

God, Father full of tenderness for your children;
you fill us with your grace, your joy and your peace.

As disciples of Christ,
We ask that every member of our Christian community
be made aware of their vocation to share their gifts and charisms by putting them at the service of
their brothers and sisters.

Send your Spirit so that,
in this new effort of evangelization,
we become flames of faith, hope and love
within our families, in our communities and in our workplaces.

We are committed to becoming your hands, your feet, your eyes in this world.
Put in us the desire to live like You
So that, through our actions and words,
we radiate your love and divine mercy.

Bless our families;
may they be environments that encourage
the vocation of marriage, priesthood or religious life.

St. Mary Star of the Sea, pray for us.
