## PASTOR'S BLOG

### **Adult Faith Formation (November 8th)**

In the liturgical calendar, the month of November leads off with the celebration of All Saints Day, a celebration of all those who have gone before us, the great cloud of witnesses, who have *run the race and kept the faith*. It is also a reminder to us that this is what we are called to as Christians - called to be saints. Those who have been enrolled into the canon of saints lived ordinary lives loving God and neighbour. The next day, after celebrating the Church Triumphant, we enter into prayer for the Church suffering, the souls in purgatory with the commemoration of All Souls. Here we are reminded that our prayers go with them beyond this life to the next and they need our prayers to help get into heaven.

The commemoration of All Souls leads into the rest of the month of November which is set aside for the intentional prayers for the dead and for a meditation on the four last things: death, judgement, heaven and hell. To enter into this meditation and for our own formation on preparing for when the Lord calls us back to himself, we will be hosting a day of formation using the program from the Augustine Institute entitled: "Eternal Life: The Art of Dying Well". The tag line used is "*Death is an end, but not THE end.*" It is a good reminder that we do not live for this life alone, there is a life to come which is eternal in which we have to think about the decisions we make today. Unfortunately today, too many people forget about the life after death or don't even believe in it. So, these sessions are timely, to form us in our own life of how to live, and as we learn, we in turn can help others.

Our day will start with Confessions at 8:30am, Mass at 9am, Hospitality and light breakfast following Mass. The program has four sessions, so we will have two before lunch and then two after lunch (we invite you to bring your own lunch to help with planning on dietary restrictions.) We will conclude at 3:30pm. The cost of the day is \$25 which will supply you with the participant workbook.

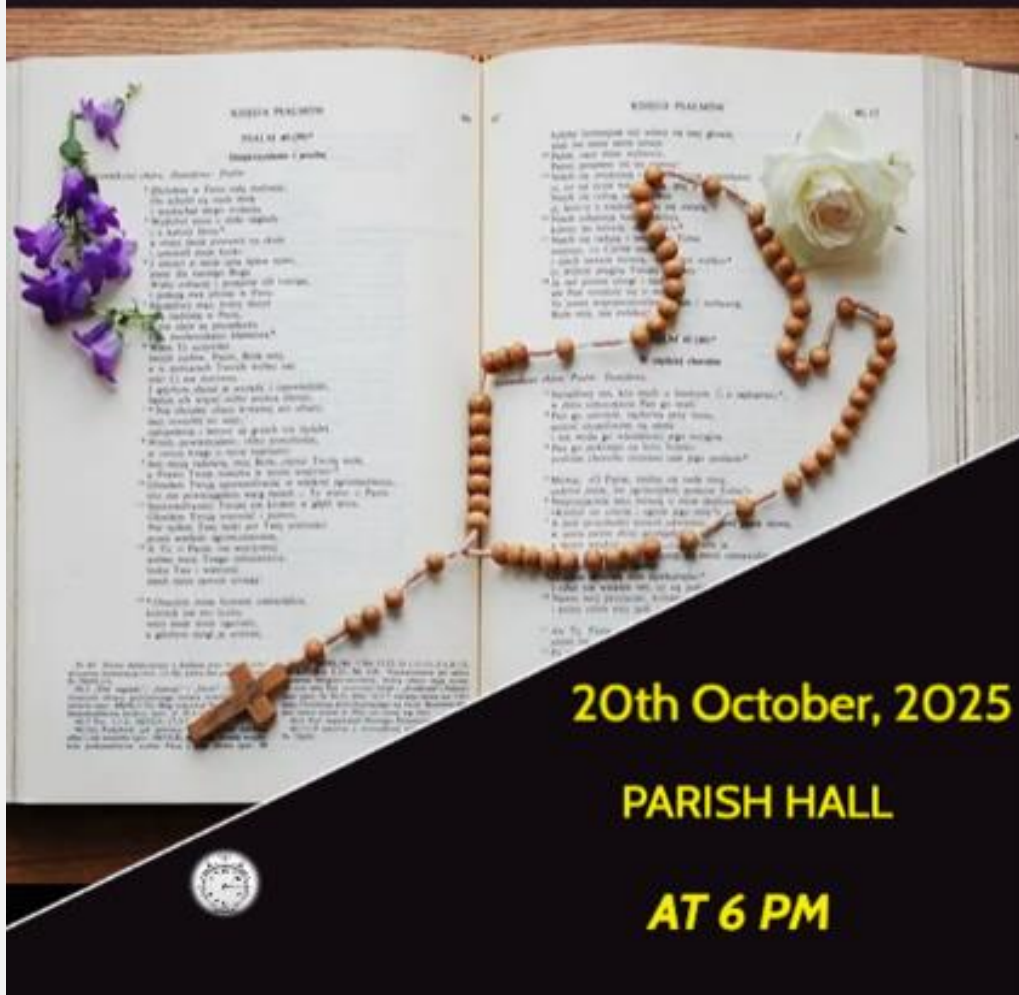
