Pastor's Corner

As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi, we give thanks for the sublime gift Jesus has entrusted to His Church: the Holy Eucharist, His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. At every Mass, Christ becomes really, truly and substantially present, offering Himself to us as spiritual nourishment and drawing us into deeper communion with Him.

In celebrating this feast, we are invited to reflect on the beauty and importance of Eucharistic Adoration. While we encounter Jesus sacramentally at Mass, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament provides a unique opportunity to remain in His presence, to gaze upon Him with faith, and to allow Him to speak to our hearts. In the silence of the church, before the Blessed Sacrament, we discover that prayer is not merely about speaking to God but about being with Him.

The saints consistently pointed to Eucharistic Adoration as a source of strength, peace, and holiness. Time spent before the Lord deepens our love for the Mass, strengthens our families, clarifies our vocation, and renews our commitment to Christian discipleship. In a world filled with noise, distractions, and anxiety, Jesus waits patiently for us in the Eucharist, inviting us to bring Him our joys, burdens, hopes, and fears.

On this Corpus Christi, I encourage every parishioner to spend time in Eucharistic Adoration. Whether for a few minutes or an hour, come and be with the Lord. He is truly present, and He longs to draw each of us closer to His Sacred Heart.
