The Presentation of Our Lord

This weekend, 40 days after Christmas, we take a brief pause in Ordinary Time to celebrate The Presentation of Our Lord Jesus in the Temple. The Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas, is a profound moment of encounter between God and His people. When Mary and Joseph present Jesus in the temple, they fulfill the law, demonstrating their deep faith and obedience. The humble setting becomes a place of divine revelation as Simeon, guided by the Holy Spirit, recognizes Jesus as the Light for all nations. His prayer of gratitude, the *Nunc Dimittis*, expresses hope and peace.

This feast challenges us to reflect on our readiness to recognize Christ's presence in the ordinary moments of life. Just as Simeon and Anna waited with patient faith, we are called to be attentive and open to God's movements in our lives. The blessing of candles during this celebration also reminds us of our mission to be bearers of light, sharing Christ's hope and love with a world that often walks in darkness. May the Presentation of the Lord inspire us to live with faith, joy, and the courage to be light for others.

Please bring your household candles to be blessed at the beginning of Mass. We will also have candles available for purchase, 2 to a box for \$5. Taper candles will be distributed and lit at the beginning of Mass in accordance with the ritual.

Marriage Sunday

This February 8th and 9th, the Archdiocese of Toronto invites us all to celebrate Marriage Sunday, a special occasion dedicated to honouring the Sacrament of Marriage and the lifelong commitment it represents. Marriage is the cornerstone of family life and a beautiful reflection of God's love for humanity. This occasion highlights the importance of the institution of marriage rooted in faith, affirms couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness, and complements World Marriage Sunday celebrations that take place across North America.

Marriage Sunday encourages us to reflect on the beauty and challenges of married life, offering a chance for couples to renew their commitment to one another. For those who are already married, this weekend serves as a reminder of the sacred promises made before God. It's a moment to express gratitude for the love and support that couples share.

In addition to recognizing the personal bond between husband and wife, Marriage Sunday also serves as a reminder of the role marriage plays within the larger faith community. This year, I invite you to take a moment to pray for married couples, families, and those preparing for marriage. Also, let us commit to strengthening the bonds of love and unity in our own lives, encouraging others to do the same.

Bishop Ivan Camilleri will preside at a special Mass on Sunday, February 9, 2025 at 2:30 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond Street, Toronto). All married couples will have an opportunity to renew their marriage commitment. All are welcome to attend. Couples celebrating a 25th, 40th, 50th, 60th or 60+ anniversary in 2025 may register for reserved seating. All other seating is on a first-come, first-served basis. Those who are unable to attend at the Cathedral are invited to join the celebration via [livestream Mass](#).
