LPA's Blog - March 1/2

Since Fr Michael is still away on pilgrimage, it is now my (Adriene's) turn to write the weekly blog. The last time I wrote the blog, I shared with you "a day in the life of the LPA". In the times before that, I would write about wedding planning updates and here I am nearly 6 months married with not many updates to give. When people ask me what married life is like, my usual response is that it truly feels like a romantic comedy!

Recently, we received the full gallery of our wedding photos and a video that highlights special moments from our big day. As Adrian and I looked through the photos and watched our wedding video, we couldn't help but feel all the emotions from that day again — the giddiness, the joy, and the overwhelming sense of love. I'm so thankful that we can look back at these memories and relive these moments of joy.

Reflecting on this, I'm reminded of our relationship with the Lord. Just as there are seasons of great joy and consolation, there are also moments of desolation and challenge. My spiritual director once shared that in times of joy, it's important to pause and truly thank God for those moments, particularly those moments of encounter with the Lord where we experience His love profoundly. He told me that during times of desolation, we can revisit these pockets of grace and relive the joy and peace that God has gifted us, strengthening us through difficult seasons.

In the next few days, we will officially begin the Lenten season. During Advent, we enter into a season of preparing for Christ's birth and now with Lent, we enter into another liturgical season of preparing for the Church's greatest celebration, Easter. As Jesus spent 40 days in the desert, we too spend these 40 days following after Him in the Lenten desert. Lent is a penitential season meant to deepen our relationship with God. It is marked by the three pillars of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. During Lent, we are called to "true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully" (USCCB).

As we approach this Lent, I encourage you to take a moment to reflect on your relationship with the Lord, especially on those moments of encounter with Him that have been filled with grace. I invite you to reflect on these gifts and hold them close, particularly as we journey through the Lenten desert. It's not enough to simply think of them as "nice" moments, but to truly reflect on and relive the grace that God has given us in them.

As a reminder, we will have two Ash Wednesday Masses on Wednesday, March 5th, at 9:00 am and 7:00 pm. We hope you can join us as we begin the Lenten season together!
