PASTOR'S BLOG

As we come to the end of the Christmas season, celebrating the Epiphany of Our Lord. Epiphany, which is also known as “Little Christmas,” is the feast that celebrates the arrival of the three Magi who had come to worship the Child Jesus shortly after his birth. It is traditionally celebrated on January 6 giving us the 12 days of Christmas. However, each bishop’s conference gets the choice of celebrating the feast on the nearest Sunday between Jan. 2 and Jan 8. Many around the world celebrate this feast with as much pomp and circumstance as Christmas, including the exchanging of gifts. As we celebrate this feast, I would like to take the opportunity to thank the parishioners for their kindness and generosity with their gifts to both me and the staff of St. Mary’s during this Christmas season. We all feel loved and know that we are appreciated by you, our parish family.

One of the traditions on the feast of the Epiphany is for Catholics to bless their homes by writing the letters C, M, and B and the numbers of the year, for example 2024, at the top of their doors. The letters stand for the names of the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. They also represent the Latin blessing *Christus mansionem benedicat*, which means “May Christ bless this house.”

In the day, priests would be able to go to each house bless each one. But with the growth of parishes and the many houses one would have to visit, many parishes will give their parishioners a piece of blessed chalk, a small bottle of holy water, and the house blessing written so that each family can go and bless their homes.

This year, we are one of those parishes. After Mass this weekend, we will have a little house blessing care package that you can bless your home (or condo). We hope that with God’s blessing upon you and your household we will be able to build the kingdom of God in Port Credit.
