PASTOR'S BLOG

Holy Week

This upcoming week is probably the most busy time of the year for any parish priest. I usually get the question, which is more busy Christmas or Easter. My answer, which I think other priests would resonate with is they are busy and tiring in their own respect. Christmas is tiring because of the amount of Masses that we have to celebrate in a week. This year, we were blessed because Christmas fell on a Sunday. But that does not happen every year. And with extra Masses on Christmas Eve and sometimes on Christmas day, it is tiring. Easter, on the other hand, is tiring because of the amount of work that goes into all the celebrations. The planning, the decorating, the rehearsals and coordinating everything can be draining. On top of that, celebrating the rituals are so meaningful and filled with grace that it drains us emotionally and spiritually. If I was to choose one, it would be Easter. Recall back, I am not much of a Christmas spirit guy...but Easter, I love it. Why? We have just been fasting and offering penances for 40 days...we should celebrate with songs and hymns, with prayers and jubilation.

I think another reason why I love Easter so much is that growing up as an altar boy and then becoming the parish MC, I learned about the rituals, their meaning and why we do what we do. It is incredible. Thankfully no altar boy at St. Mary's has to hold the Roman Missal during the Good Friday general intercessions like I did. I will never forget when the priest celebrating the service just lightly rested the book on my forehead and whispered, "your arms need a rest." LOL

With that, if you have never been to the Masses and services over the Easter Triduum, that is Holy Thursday, the Mass of the Lord's Supper, Good Friday, the Celebration of the Lord's passion or the Easter Vigil, the mother of all vigils, you should come out. And you might be thinking, it is going to be crowded...trust me, there will be room. And, if you know anyone at some of the larger parishes in Mississauga who are looking for a place that is calm and quaint, invite them down to St. Mary's!

Divine Mercy Novena

On Saturday March 18th our parish hosted a Lenten retreat where the new Icon of Divine Mercy was revealed. As those in attendance learned, the Icon was not complete. Due to timing and weather, mostly weather, the anointing of the Icon could not be completed in time. The Icon is safely back in the US and Minh, the iconographic, is hard at work completing the final stage. God willing, it will be returned to us and mounted before the Easter Vigil.

With the Divine Mercy Icon with us, I wanted to try something new and that is to pray the Novena of the Divine Mercy together as a parish family. The Novena traditionally begins on Good Friday and concludes on the 2nd Sunday of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday. Here is the schedule and I hope you can make it out.

- 1) Good Friday - April 7th - After the 3pm service
- 2) Easter Saturday - April 8th - 9am
- 3) Easter Sunday - April 9th - 8:30am
- 4) Easter Monday - April 10th - 3pm
- 5) Easter Tuesday - April 11th - 3pm
- 6) Easter Wednesday - April 12th - During Adoration
- 7) Easter Thursday - April 13th - During Adoration
- 8) Easter Friday - April 14th - During Adoration
- 9) Easter Saturday - April 15th - After 9am Mass
- 2nd Sunday of Easter - April 16th - Divine Mercy Sunday - Holy Hour at 3pm
