Blessing of the Backpacks

Since 2022, the staff and leadership team have been looking for ways to connect with our parish schools outside of the normal school liturgies. One of the ideas that I had while on my cottage getaway was to have the blessing of backpacks. This is an opportunity to extend an invitation to the families who attend our parish schools, St Luke's and St. James' along with all other families who homeschool or send their children to private or the public school and to those who have their children in day care to come to the parish and begin their school year with a blessing. And yes, even high school students are welcome! We look forward to welcoming all the children and teens of our parish families on the weekend of September 28/29 at all Masses where the blessing will take place after communion.

Backpack Drive

One of the ideas that I had while on a little trip across the border was found in a church that we visited: a Backpack drive. Through this drive, we wish to provide backpacks and school supplies to our parish schools and to other charities who may need them. We know that having the proper school supplies are needed to excel in school and some of our neighbours in need could certainly benefit from these items. We also know that school items get exhausted, lost or misplaced. These backpacks and school items can certainly assist in these situations. Please bring a backpack filled with school items (See Picture above) to the parish on the weekend of September 28/29th for them to be blessed and we will distribute to the schools. You may also bring just school supplies to the parish any weekend leading up to September 28th/29th and we will get them to the schools and those who are in need.
