## PASTOR'S BLOG

In my homily on the 3rd Sunday of Easter, I made mention of opening your Bibles and not to be passive but active in nurturing your faith. I would add that opening your Catechisms would also be an important step in nurturing your faith. I then went on to say that you have access to the Augustine Institute's FORMED platform for free. (The parish has a subscription thanks to your generous financial support of our parish programs).

First, you might be wondering why we as a parish subscribe to FORMED. Well, the internet and online streaming has certainly opened the doors to access the World Wide Web of content that is out there. But in my experience, there is a lot of "Catholic" content online through YouTube and other platforms, but it is difficult to navigate what is trustworthy and to avoid the rabbit hole of sinking deeper into thought that might seem good but can be leading one astray from the Catholic faith. However, having used the content on FORMED, I can say with confidence that it is trustworthy and will assist you as you walk your pilgrimage of faith.

So, by mentioning, endorsing and encouraging you to take advantage of the content on FORMED, I wanted to use this blog to draw your attention to some of the programs that I have found helpful.

### **Bible Studies**

The "Lectio" Collection by the team at the Augustine Institute provides different Bible Studies for different topics. There are bible studies that walk you through a particular book on the Bible, for example, The Gospel of Mark or St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians. There are other studies that take you through a particular topic/mystery/theme, for example Mary or Salvation or The Case for Jesus.

This would be a good option to help you grow in your understanding of Sacred Scripture, to learn the story and to see your life through the lens of Scripture.

### **Faith Formation**

There are many different video series to help you grow in your faith and understanding of mysteries of the faith. Some of these are used in our Sacramental Preparation, mostly Baptism Preparation and RCIA. For Baptism Preparation we use the "Reborn" series and for RCIA we use "Symbolon". Currently, the Augustine Institute is re-filming the Symbolon series, so I look forward to its completion.

But there are other video series that might be helpful. I hope to be able to have small/large group nights at the parish to watch these together and then have some small group discussion following. One is with regards to Reconciliation called "Forgiven". Another is on the Eucharist called "Presence". There is a video on the four last things called "Eternal Life".

### **Saints**

There are a lot of different movies on the lives of saints. A lot of these probably have subtitles because they were filmed in France or Italy. But still worth to check out if you are looking for a movie for movie night at home. I noticed they have one for St. Ignatius of Loyola, St. Joan of Arc and St. John Bosco.

### **Children Content**

If you want good Catholic content for your children, there are videos for all ages. The Brother Francis series is a favourite of mine. (Yes, you can learn a lot from the children's content!)

I hope that is a good primer to get you started. If you are looking for recommendations, just send me an email, call me or speak to me after Mass. Always happy to point you in a direction to help you in your understanding of the faith.

toward our goal of \$108,000**




