Pastor's Corner: Second Sunday of Advent

As we enter into the sacred rhythm of Advent, one of the mysteries that we are invited to enter into is the mystery of God's Justice and Judgement.

This week and last week, we are confronted with the truth that God will come to judge the living and the dead. And that the judgement at the second coming of the Christ is not the first time that God judged the nations. In the days of Noah, God judged the world when He sent a flood upon the land that had turned their back on Him and only Noah and his family were saved in the Ark. God continually judged Israel in the promised land when they broke the covenant and sent judges to bring repentance and conversation. God judged Israel when they turned their back on Him and sent them into exile in Babylon. God judged the world in sending His only begotten Son who received the just sentence that was due to us when He died on the cross.

So, in preparation for the second coming of the Jesus, knowing that there will be a general judgment on the world, we prepare our hearts through repenting our sins in the Sacrament of Confession and works of charity, which there is not shortage of opportunities in our parish and community. Both of these actions helps us grow in the virtue of humility to climb the mountain of God.
