The pastor's blog returns after a three week hiatus. As for me, in that time, I had a good week away from the parish with my classmates from St. Augustine's. Nothing like going up to a cottage and just breaking from the day to day grind and routine.

We are now at the halfway mark of the summer break from parish activity but it certainly does not feel like it. A couple weeks ago we hosted our Totus Tuus summer camp. This is not my first experience of this summer camp. In 2012, when I was a seminarian intern at St. Marguerite D'Youville parish in Brampton, I was in the coordinator role hosting the camp. It brought a lot of youthful energy to the parish and it also brought the parish together for the sake of the youth. The next time I would have a connection to Totus Tuus would be as an associate pastor for both my years at St. Isaac Jogues parish in Pickering. However, after the first day he wanted to come back and was excited about his new friends and the new lessons. And having the children join us for the parish Mass on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday was so precious. They responded to the prayers, they sang hymns and they were genuinely happy to be at Mass.
