SSVP – ST. VINCENT DE PAUL AND BLESSED FREDERIC OZANAM

Sept. 27 is the feast day of St. Vincent de Paul. Born in 1581, he is recognized as the patron saint of charitable works. His feast day commemorates his life and contributions to the poor and marginalized. He said "Go to the poor: you will find God. The poor are your masters. You are the servant." Earlier this month, we celebrated the feast day of Blessed Frederic Ozanam (Sept. 9), the founder of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul. Born in 1813, Ozanam, who chose St. Vincent de Paul as his model and patron, said "The knowledge of social well being can be learned not from books but in climbing the stairs to the poor person's attic, sitting by their fireside, feeling the same cold that pierces them, sharing the secrets of their lonely hearts and their troubled minds." Please pray for all Vincentians, who feel called to continue this work of charity and consolation.

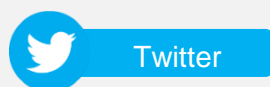
