PASTOR'S BLOG

Habemus Papam

With the joy of the Risen Lord, we thank God for the election of the Successor of St. Peter, the American born Cardinal, Robert Prevost who took the name Leo. These next few days, months and years, we will get to know more about Pope Leo XIV through his pastoral ministry. In the meantime, we lift him up in prayer that the Holy Spirit may guide him to guide the Church in unity and peace. May God grant wisdom and strength to our Holy Father. We also pray for Frank Cardinal Leo and Thomas Cardinal Collins that they have a safe journey back to Toronto.

Looking ahead...Save the Dates

We are entering into the 4th week of Easter, and that just means our shift in focus in the liturgy moves towards focusing on the life in Christ within the Church. We start with Good Shepherd Sunday and continue along towards the celebrations of the Ascension of Our Lord and Pentecost.

With these solemnities fast approaching, I would like to invite you to our **Parish Mission “Unlock the Door” - 9 days of Masses (Thursday May 29th - Sunday June 8th)** that will help us in our preparation for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. I have invited Fr Allan MacDonald, CC to lead the Mission, celebrating and preaching these Novena of Masses. Please see the schedule attached to this email.

Please note, during this time, the 9am Masses (with the exception of Saturdays) will be cancelled. We want everyone in our parish family to come to the mission so that they can experience what the Apostles experienced in that first Pentecost - the transforming power of the Holy Spirit.

Ordination Weekend

On the second Saturday of the month of May, the Archdiocese of Toronto celebrates the Sacrament of Holy Orders - men being ordained to the Priesthood. This year, the Archdiocese has 3 young men who will be ordained and will be serving in parishes throughout the GTA. Please offer your prayers for:

- 1) Rev. Fr James Cyfko
- 2) Rev. Fr Alvin Joys
- 3) Rev. Fr Jesus Fidel Anon

While 3 men being ordained is a time to celebrate as an Archdiocese, we must continue to pray for an increase in vocations. Fr Matt McCarthy (who frequently assists me over weekends at the parish) has said very clearly, the only thing that the Lord asked us to do for vocations is pray - *Pray to the Lord of the harvest, that He may send Labourers into His harvest*. I would invite you, echoing the invitation of Frank Cardinal Leo, to offer 3 Hail Marys daily for this specific intention.

Mother's Day

Usually Ordination Weekend coincides with Mother's Day - and they are not mutually exclusive of each other. There is pious tradition that pays respect to the role of a mother in the life of a newly ordained priest's formation. To recognize this, the newly ordained priest gives to his mum the *maniturgium*. This is the white linen towel that is used to wipe the chrism oil that anoints the hands of the priest by the bishop. The oil that is used on the hands of the priest is sacred, having been previously blessed by the bishop, and so the *maniturgium* cannot be discarded in the trash. While it could be thrown in the laundry basket to be cleaned, priests over the years decided to save these linen towels and present them to their mothers at their first Mass.

According to an age-old tradition the mother saves the towel in a safe place until she dies. Then when her body is prepared for the funeral the *maniturgium* is placed within the hands of the mother. The pious tradition then narrates what happens when the priest's mother arrives at the pearly gates of heaven.

When she arrives to the gates of heaven she is escorted directly to our Lord. Our Lord says to the woman “—I have given you life, what have you given to me?” She hands him the *maniturgium* and responds, “I have given you my son as a priest.” At this Jesus grants her entry into paradise.

It is a beautiful and consoling tradition that is always a touching ceremony to witness. Many more tears are shed when a young priest presents the towel to his mother, tears of joy instead of sorrow. 11 years ago, I remember vividly these tears shed and the joy shared between mum and I. Not so many tears these days except that of laughter and joy.

This weekend we will be distributing the spring edition, issue 3, of *Fiat Magazine*. While the previous issues featured our ministries, their presence and activity in the parish, this issue brings our focus towards our finances. Every year we are required, as a charity, to provide you with an annual financial statement. Over the previous years I have had that statement published as an insert/attachment to our weekly newsletter. The parish finance council and I decided that we would use our magazine as the medium to distribute this financial statement. It allows for more transparency with our parish finances and gives a proper report on our financial health that is accessible to all. We hope that you pick up a copy and respond with generosity to our parish's need.

On Retreat

Finally, say a prayer for me and many other priests who are heading on the mandatory priest retreat this week. We begin on Monday morning and conclude Thursday at lunch. For me, it will be a nice time away to focus on the things of heaven rather than those of the earth with my brother priests

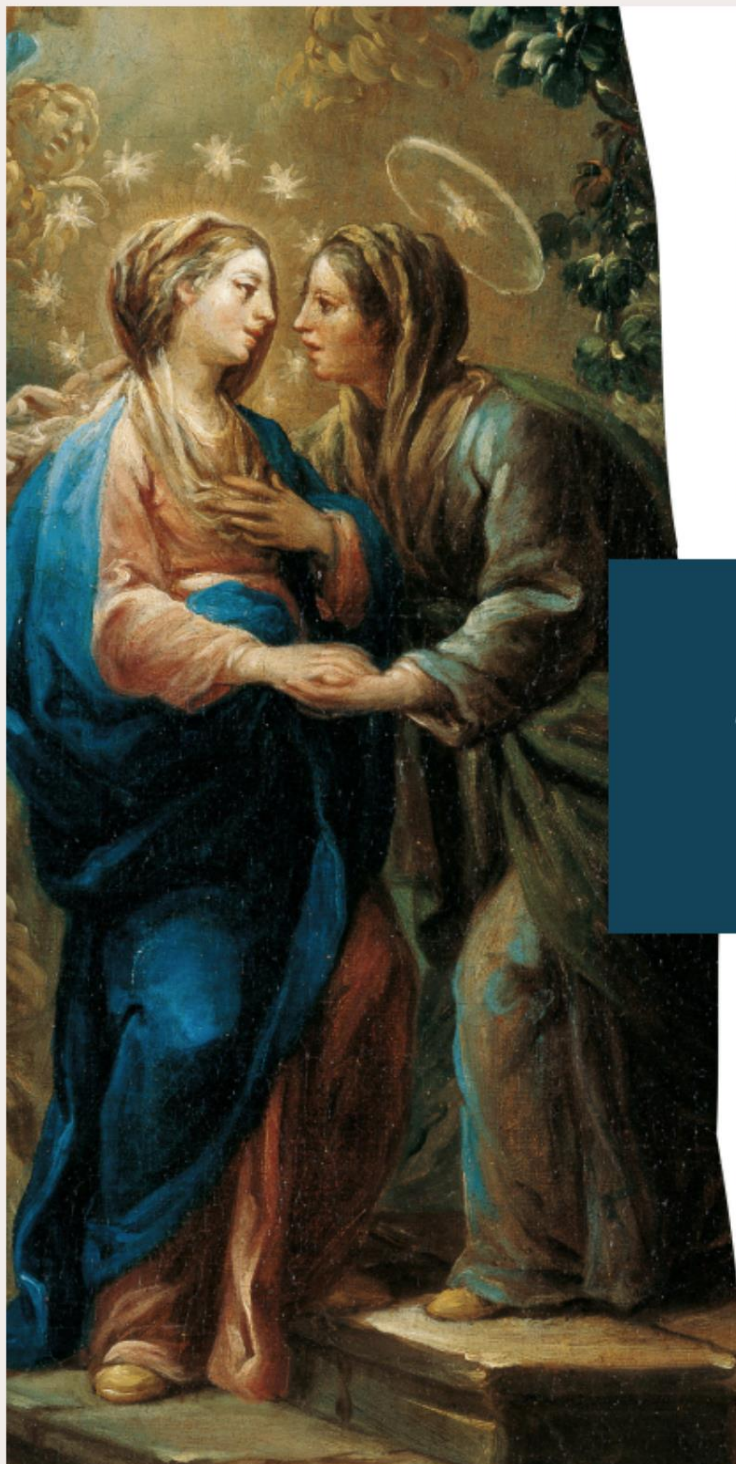
SHARELIFE - SOW THE SEEDS OF HOPE FOR THE NEXT GENERATION
