Youth Minister's Blog: Go into the world and proclaim the good news!

As a part of Confirmation preparation we are hosting a retreat and during this retreat there is a session in which we asked the Confirmandi to submit anonymous questions. They could ask whatever they want, no judgement, and we will do our best to give them the Catholic answer.

We got one fantastic question that I would like to address in this blog :) The question is: ***Is there anything you have to do after Confirmation or do you just live your life as before but with the Holy Spirit?***

I love this question for many reasons but the main reason is because I like to think the apostles thought the same thing shortly after the ascension. I can imagine the collective “Welp...what do we do now?” thought. The Lord has ascended to the Father and there are people out there that very much want them dead because of Who they follow. What do they do now?

The answer I am giving to our Confirmation candidates is the same thing that Jesus said to the apostles, “Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation.” The same thing that Jesus tells each and everyone one of us to do. At Confirmation the gifts of the Holy Spirit - Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord - are sealed and strengthened. We are called to use these gifts to build up the kingdom of God while we are here on earth. They’re not meant to lie dormant, think about if you got a really nice car as a gift, you accepted it, but never drove it! What a waste!

I wanted to bring this question/answer to the blog because it serves twofold as an answer to the question for the candidates as well as a reminder for us all. If someone you knew was getting Confirmed...even if one of our Confirmation candidates this year came up to you and asked you this question and asked for an example from your life, what would you tell them? How have you been spreading the good news? Something to think about this Ascension weekend!

I can’t leave this blog without wishing all of the mothers a very happy Mother’s Day! To all the mothers, grandmother’s, God Mothers, religious sisters and mother figures, the happiest day to you! The youth of the parish are invited to join us for Totus Tuus Summer Camp this summer the week of July 15th! For those of you who may not know. Totus Tuus is an Archdiocesan program whereby seminarians and young adults travel to different parishes, spreading the Good News of our Lord through catechesis, Mass, Confession, songs and games! The Day camp is for children entering grades 1-6 and runs Monday to Friday and the Evening Program is for youth entering grades 7-12 and runs Sunday to Thursday. The cost is only \$125/child for the whole week for the day program and \$25/child for the whole week for the evening program.
